

RACER GATE ENTRY PROCEDURES

(Effective June 7, 2009)

In an effort to speed up the racer entry gate and cause as little disruption as possible to racers staying overnight at SIR the following changes to gate procedures are being implemented effective immediately:

- 1- Racers and crews paying a full weekend fee will continue to receive wrist bands however you will now only need to sign the release waiver form **ONCE** during the weekend (when you first enter the track). When you enter the gate the following day simply show your wrist band **THAT MUST BE PROPERLY ATTACHED TO YOUR WRIST** to the gate person and you will be permitted to enter without having to sign the release waiver form again.
- 2- **VERY IMPORTANT: THE WRIST BANDS NEED TO BE WORN ON THE PERSON'S WRIST AS PROOF THAT THE PERSON WEARING THE WRIST BAND SIGNED THE RELEASE WAIVER FORM. ANYONE NOT WEARING THEIR WRIST BAND ON THEIR WRIST WILL HAVE TO SIGN THE RELEASE WAIVER FORMS EACH AND EVERY TIME THEY ENTER THE TRACK, OR WALK THROUGH THE PIT PASS GATE. PLEASE HELP SPEED UP THE GATE PROCESS AND ASSIST THE GATE STAFF BY WEARING YOUR WRIST BAND PROPERLY. IF THIS PROBLEM CANNOT BE RECTIFIED WE MAY HAVE TO GO BACK TO EVERYONE SIGNING THE RELEASE WAIVER FORM EACH DAY.**
- 3- Racers and crews that have paid for a full weekend fee and are staying overnight at SIR will be issued a new "**SIR WAIVER**" sticker that **MUST** be displayed on the door of the racer's camper/RV. Racers displaying the SIR WAIVER sticker will no longer be required to get up early Sunday morning in order to sign the release waiver form. If you are not displaying your SIR WAIVER sticker you will be woken up early by the gate staff, so please remember to display your sticker.
- 4- Racers and crews staying overnight that have not paid a full weekend fee will need to sign the release waiver form and pay their appropriate fees early Sunday morning prior to the racer gate opening. Please ensure that you and your entire crew are awake when the gate staff arrives at your pit. As a general rule the gate staff will begin making their rounds at 7:00 a.m. so please set your alarms accordingly.
